We remember those aren't able to be with us today, some recovering from illness and/or surgery: Tom Craven and Sharon Sears.

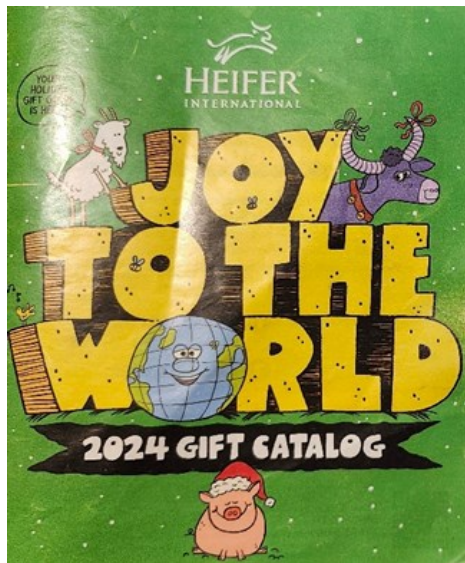
